Dear Members and Friends of Trinity,

Thank you to everyone who attended the town hall meetings after service on the 3rd and 4th of February. We discussed making some changes to our ministries here at Trinity. Your feedback and insights were needed and much appreciated. PPC has discussed what was shared and approved the shift in ministry focus.

We feel more folks will benefit more in our congregation and surrounding community if we shift our focus from summer children's ministries to a more senior-focused ministry year round. Coming out of the town hall meetings, we have identified a senior ministry team, and we are going to get them rolling ASAP.

Bur first, I want to relay to you that our Bitty Ballin' and Raising Up Readers programs are going to continue. We have renewed our partnership with both the recreation department and the school district to keep those programs going. We are going to be more intentional about sharing Jesus in Raising Up Readers using bible storybooks more often and targeting the parents more. Bitty Ballin' will be as it has been, a revenue stream to pay for other programming. We will still need volunteers for these programs and will be

looking to the congregation and outside service groups to staff them and in so doing, also seeking to minister to and invite any volunteers from outside our fellowship to church. However, revamping VBS is still a work in progress and may not happen for this summer.

The reasoning behind starting up some new senior ministry ventures is that it will be a great opportunity to invite friends and neighbors to events and ongoing programs that will benefit and be of assistance to seniors.

Some of that will simply be looking out for each other with check-ins and maybe even some health screening and wellness programs, but we are also looking into running day trips and programs for leisure, learning and even exercise for seniors and older adults. These are things that our own people will enjoy, but can also invite friends and neighbors to come to and meet other folks from Trinity with the hope that we can invite them to church. This will involve collaborating with other churches who have similar programs, but we will also develop our own.

Again, a team is in place to get going, but any feedback you have on this is welcome and needed. Please contact me with anything at all.




